Branford Marsalis is a National Endowment of the Arts Jazz Master, a renowned Grammy Award winning saxophonist, and Tony Award winning composer, and has widely been considered to be one of the more revered instrumentalists of our time. Grammy Award winner Kurt Elling is among the world's foremost jazz vocalists, named the Jazz Journalists Association's Male Singer of the Year on eight occasions, and has won the DownBeat Critics Poll for an astonishing fourteen consecutive years. In 2015, the pair came together to create a Grammy nominated collaborative album entitled *Upward Spiral*, containing songs selected for their melodic richness and unique musical quality.
